<b>Description</b>	<p>Accompanying PowerPoint slides and study guides were used in fall 2017, but will be revised according to efficacy and feedback from our first cohort of students.</p> <p>Self-contained exercises in unit modules were used in summer 2016 and will be revised. All resources will be compiled and made available via a LibGuide for use in online courses or face-to-face instruction.</p>
<b>Timeline</b>	<p>During the January, Spring, and Maymester 2018 terms, we will compile instructor materials we created and used upon adoption of Psychology by OpenSTAX and review them to identify areas of needed improvements and suggested revisions within materials (slides, guides, and modules).</p> <p>During/In Summer 2018, materials will be revised with additional examples, images, alternative exercises, and revisions. A student worker will aid with developing, and mostly organizing, these additional materials. In Fall 2018, a LibGuide, will be created and finalized so that the PSYC 1101 ancillaries will be posted and available for use publicly.</p> <p>Psychology faculty will be invited to an instructional session about adopting OpenStax and the created instructor materials.</p>
