<b>Description</b>	<p>In Fall 2015, a team of faculty from the Georgia Southwestern State University (GSW) Department of Psychology and Sociology received a grant from Affordable Learning Georgia to implement an OER in the PSYC 2103 (Human Growth and Development) class. This OER was first used in all four sections of PSYC 2103 that were taught in Spring 2016, and has been used in all sections of this course at GSW since that time. We have also created an online test bank, PowerPoint slides, and various writing and discussion assignments to supplement the OER content.</p> <p>Our initial implementation of the OER involved using the “Human Development” chapter from the Introductory Psychology textbook published at that time by Boundless.com (and now hosted by Lumen Learning at <a href="https://courses.lumenlearning.com/boundless-psychology/">https://courses.lumenlearning.com/boundless-psychology/</a>). While the general range of topics and organization of this resource are compatible with the goals of the course, the instructors feel that the OER is lacking in its depth of coverage. The proposed minigrant is requested to enable expansion of the content in this OER.</p> <p>It is anticipated that the basic structure of the OER will remain fundamentally the same – specifically, that the resulting product will continue to be a chronologically-organized textbook covering physical, cognitive, and socioemotional development across the lifespan as well as coverage of relevant topics such as major theories of development, research methodology in developmental psychology, and the influence of cultural and societal factors on development. However, the content in the existing OER will be expanded upon by incorporating content from other sources.
