Project Description	We will be creating ancillaries for this existing OER as well as creating an online class. About 250 students per year take this class. The existing text for this class was \$150 new, so there will be significant savings with the use of this OER. With the shift to an OER will require creation of test, quizzes, presentation slides, etc.
Timeline and Personnel	Our timeline is to have the ancillaries started this summer of 2019. Our hope is to incorporate them as early as this coming fall but definitely by the spring of 2020.
